

USING PROTECTED MAIL QUARANTINE

SETTING UP YOUR ACCOUNT:

Go to <http://www.protectedmail.net> and click on “[Need to activate your account?](#)”



Enter your email address in the field provided, and click “Activate”. You will then be sent two separate emails.

The first will be an address verification email. Click the link, and you will be directed to the Protected Mail login screen. Enter your email address in the field provided.

Your password is contained in the second email. Enter it in the space provided. The next screen will allow you to change your password to whatever you want it to be.

Enter your temporary password, and then a password you choose. Repeat your new password, and click “Change Password”. In the next screen, you will be able to set your preferences.

PREFERENCES:

Click on the “Preferences” tab in the upper right hand corner of the page

Here, you can set up email aliases, control your quarantine email options, and set up an RSS feed for your quarantine.

You will be sent an address verification email for all aliases you set up on Protected Mail. Click on the link in the email to activate the quarantine for your alias(es).


QUARANTINE:

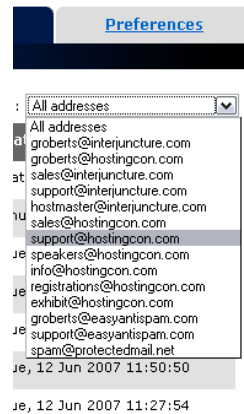

If you want to see the quarantine for a specific address, click the arrow on the right side of the drop down box, and select the address from the list.



To see a specific message, click on the subject line and the message will open in a separate window. At the bottom of the window are the options for the specific message: [Deliver](#) | [Deliver & Report](#) | [Delete](#)

If the spam is something you would like to save for later viewing, click “Deliver” and the spam will be delivered to your email inbox.

If the message was falsely identified as spam, “Deliver & Report” will deliver the message to your inbox, and report to MailFoundry that the message was not spam.

To simply eliminate the message from your quarantine, click “Delete”.

All of these actions can be taken on multiple messages by checking the box(es) on the left side of the message(s), clicking on the drop down box at the bottom of the quarantine view screen, and then selecting the action from the drop down menu. Click “GO” to carry out the action.
